



Volunteer Code of Conduct

Nittany Greyhounds expects our volunteers to adhere to the highest standard of conduct and professionalism so that we may continue to maintain our reputation as a premier greyhound adoption organization. In performing any service for or representing Nittany Greyhounds, we expect you to agree to meet the following standards of conduct:

- Represent Nittany Greyhounds in a polite and professional manner at all times
- Treat all Nittany Greyhounds, staff, donors, clients, and animals with respect and kindness at all times and shall not engage in any unacceptable behavior, which includes, but is not limited to:
 - Displaying discourtesy
 - Engaging in rude behavior
 - Using verbal, written, physical, or visual means to harass any individual associated or doing business with Nittany Greyhounds
- You will not operate or act in any manner that is contrary to the best interests of Nittany Greyhounds
- You will wear the appropriate attire for your Volunteer Assignment
- You will arrive on time and be reliable for your Volunteer Assignment
- You will not accept or seek on behalf of any person, any financial advantage or gain as a result of your affiliation with Nittany Greyhounds
- You will not publicly use any Nittany Greyhounds affiliation in connection with the promotion of partisan politics, religious matters, or positions on any issue not in conformity with the official position of Nittany Greyhounds and without the express written permission of Nittany Greyhounds
- Nittany Greyhounds is racing neutral, and we require any personal opinions about racing to not be publically stated while you are representing Nittany Greyhounds
- You will not operate or act in a manner that creates a conflict with the interests of Nittany Greyhounds and any organization in which you have a personal, business, or financial interest
